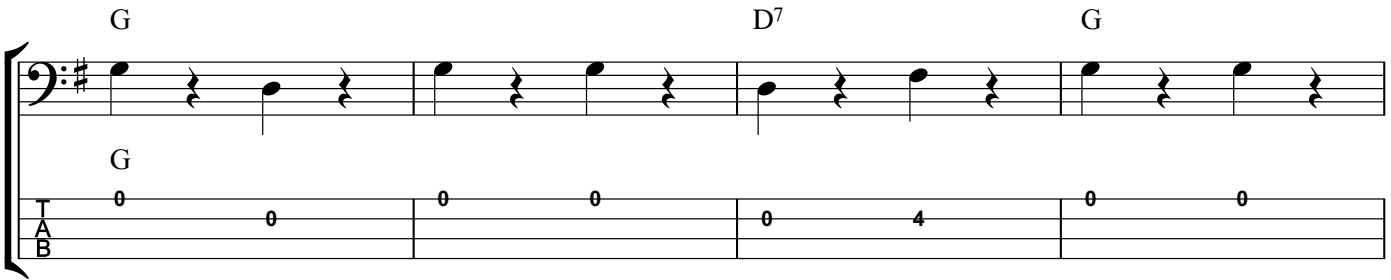

Chords: G, D7, G

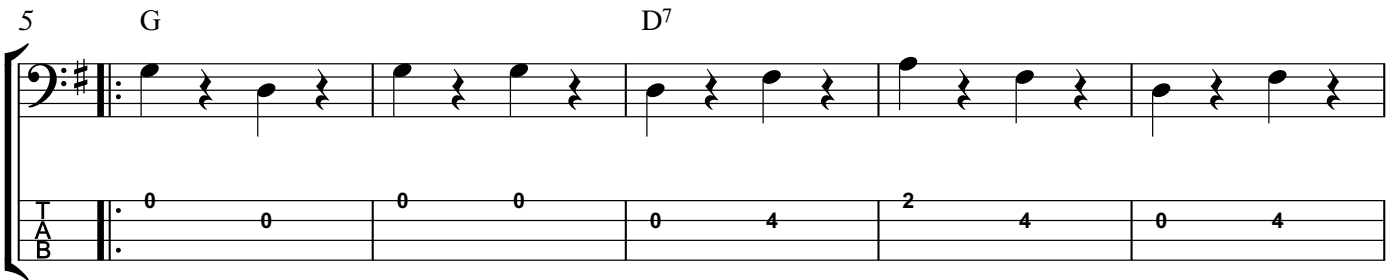

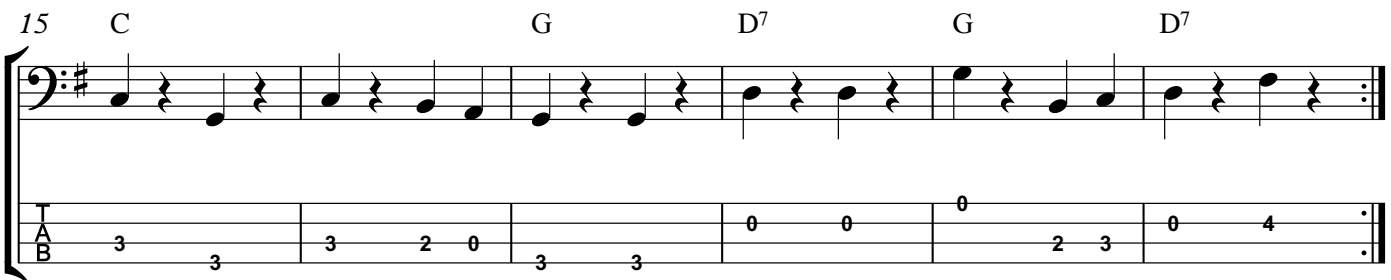
